I, Jeanne C. Finegan, declare as follows:

INTRODUCTION

1. I am the Managing Director and Head of Kroll Notice Media Solutions (“Kroll Media”),¹ a business unit of Kroll Settlement Administration LLC (“Kroll”), the proposed Settlement Administrator in the above-captioned case. This declaration is based upon my personal knowledge as well as information provided to me by my associates and staff, including information reasonably relied upon in the fields of advertising media and communications. This declaration is being filed in connection with final approval of the Settlement.

2. Kroll was appointed as the Claims Administrator, to provide notification and claims administration services in connection with that certain Settlement Agreement and Release (the “Settlement Agreement”) entered into in this Litigation, including to develop and implement the Substitute Media Notice portion of the Notice

Program that is reasonably calculated to provide Notice to Settlement Class Members in connection with the Settlement.

3. This declaration provides a report concerning the successful implementation of the Notice Program, as previously detailed to the Court in the *Declaration of Jeanne C. Finegan, APR of Kroll Settlement Administration LLC in Connection With Preliminary Approval of Settlement*, filed October 6, 2023. The Notice Program commenced on January 12, 2024, and was substantially completed on February 11, 2024.

4. The Substitute Media Notice employed best-in-class tools and technology and optimizations which, in combination with Mail Notice, ultimately reached an estimated 81.6% of potential Class Members, *i.e.*, Adults over the age of 35, on average 1.4 times. In total, the Notice Program served over 56,000,000 online display and social media ads.

SUMMARY OF THE NOTICE PROGRAM

5. The Notice Program included the following components, each of which is described in more detail below:

- Receiving and analyzing the Settlement Class Member contact information (the “Class List”) provided by Kroll Information Assurance, LLC, the outside cybersecurity experts Defendant worked with immediately following the Incident;
- A post office box for the receipt of mail;
- A neutral, informational Settlement Website;
- A toll-free interactive voice response (“IVR”) telephone hotline;
- Notice pursuant to the Class Action Fairness Act (“CAFA”) to applicable government officials;

- Mail Notice via postcard to all reasonably ascertainable Settlement Class Members;
- Publication via online display banner;
- Publication via social media advertising through Facebook and Instagram;
- Google keyword search advertising; and
- Issuing a Press release.

DATA AND CASE SETUP

The Class List

6. On December 11, 2023, Kroll received three (3) data file(s) from Kroll Information Assurance, LLC. The first file contained 881,794 records, the second file contained 896,426 records, and the third file contained 611,885 records, all with membership numbers, client identifiers, first and last names, physical mailing addresses, and information contained on the Incident letters for Settlement Class Members. Kroll undertook several steps to reconcile the three lists and compile the eventual Class List for the sending of Mail Notices. A total of 2,629 duplicate records were removed. A total of forty (40) records were removed due to missing and/or incomplete addresses. The data was reformatted; de-duped based on names and addresses; and combined into a single data file comprising 2,387,436 unique records. Additionally, in an effort to ensure that Mail Notices would be deliverable to Settlement Class Members, Kroll ran the Class List through the United States Postal Service's National Change of Address ("NCOA") database and updated the Class List with address changes received from the NCOA.

Post Office Box

7. On September 22, 2023, Kroll designated a post office box with the mailing address *Lincare Holdings, Inc. Class Action*, c/o Kroll Settlement Administration LLC, PO Box 225391, New York, NY 10150-5391, in order to receive opt out notifications, objections, Claim Forms, and correspondence from Settlement Class Members.

Settlement Website

8. On December 6, 2023, Kroll created a dedicated Settlement Website entitled www.LincareSettlement.com. The Settlement Website “went live” on January 11, 2024, and contains notice of and information about the Settlement, a copy of the Settlement Agreement, the Notice, the Preliminary Approval Order, the Claim Form, the Complaint, an “Important Dates” section that prominently lists the notable dates and deadlines concerning the Settlement, and allowed Settlement Class Members an opportunity to file a Claim Form online. As of February 13, 2024, Kroll has received 93,042 total unique users to the Settlement Website.

Toll-Free Information Telephone Line

9. On December 14, 2023, Kroll established a Telephone Hotline, (833) 383-4044, for Settlement Class Members to call and obtain additional information regarding the Settlement through an Interactive Voice Response (“IVR”) system and/or by being connected to a live operator. As of February 13, 2024, the IVR has received 15,791 calls totaling approximately 14,059 minutes, and 4,599 callers have been connected to live operators.

CAFA NOTICE

10. As noted above, on behalf of the Defendant, Kroll provided notice of the proposed Settlement pursuant to the Class Action Fairness, Act 28 U.S.C. §1715(b) (“the CAFA Notice”). At Defendant’s counsel’s direction, on October 16, 2023, Kroll sent the CAFA Notice, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, via first-class certified mail, to (a) the Attorney General of the United States and (b) the 56 state and territorial Attorneys General identified in the service list for the CAFA Notice, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. The CAFA Notice directed the Attorneys General to the website www.CAFANotice.com, a site that contains all the documents relating to the Settlement referenced in the CAFA Notice.

MAIL NOTICE VIA POSTCARD

11. On January 12, 2024, Kroll caused 2,387,436 Mail Notices to be sent via first-class mail. A true and correct copy the Mail Notice, along with the long form Notice, are attached hereto as **Exhibits C and D**, respectively.

12. As of February 13, 2024, 12,652, Notices were returned by USPS with a forwarding address. Of those, 12,233, Mailed Notices were automatically re-mailed to the updated addresses provided by USPS. The remaining 419 Mailed Notices were re-mailed by Kroll to the updated address provided by the USPS.

13. As of February 13, 2024, 144,064, Mailed Notices were returned by the USPS as undeliverable as addressed, without a forwarding address. Kroll ran 144,064, undeliverable records through an advanced address search. The advanced address

search produced 87,823, updated addresses. Kroll is in the process of re mailing Mailed Notices to the 87,823 updated addresses obtained from the advance address search.

ONLINE DISPLAY ADVERTISING

14. Kroll Media utilized a programmatic² noticing approach, employing a computer algorithm to show a specific advertisement to a specific visitor in a specific context, *i.e.*, on a particular website that a potential Settlement Class Member is visiting across an allow list³ of approximately 6,000 websites. These advertisements were device agnostic and appeared across desktop, laptop, tablet, and mobile device.

15. Online display advertisements were targeted to adults over the age of 35, to people who have respiratory ailments, heart disease, or sleep disorders as well as parents of infants, toddlers and young children who have the same. Banner ads also appeared within topic relevant content and on age relevant websites including aarp.org, cnn.com, website.com and website.com among others.

² Programmatic refers to computerized media buying of advertising inventory. The mechanics of programmatically serving an online ad are as follows: a user visits a website, and the browser sends a request to the publisher's web server asking for the page's content (*i.e.*, HTML). An invocation code placed on the page loads an external static ad tracker code. The ad tracker makes a request to the ad server querying for an ad markup (also called creative tag) to be loaded into the ad slot. The ad server responds with the ad markup code (before it's returned, the ad server executes all targeting/campaign matching logic). Finally, the publisher's web server returns the information rendering the page's content with specifically targeted ads to that user.

³ An "allow list" is a custom list of acceptable websites where ad content may be served. Creating an allow list helps to mitigate ad fraud, ensure ads will be served in relevant digital environments to the target audience and helps to ensure that ads will not appear next to offensive or objectionable content.

SOCIAL MEDIA ADVERTISING

16. Social media ads on Facebook and Instagram appeared across users' newsfeeds, stories, and videos. These ads employed multiple layers of targeting and focused on adults over the age of 35 as well as Facebook and Instagram users who have *liked, followed or interacted* with relevant pages, accounts, videos, posts and/or tags. Such pages and accounts included Respiratory Care, Neonatal & Pediatric Respiratory Review, COPD Net, CPAP Com, COPD, Respiratory Support, and Asthma Awareness. Post and hashtags included *#Lincare, #respiratory disorders, #nebulizer, #oxygentherapy* and *#parentsofpreemies*, among others.

17. A true and correct copy of the display banner ads and social media ads are attached hereto as **Exhibit E**.

GOOGLE KEYWORD SEARCH ADS

18. Kroll Media utilized keyword search advertisements on Google. When searching for specific keywords or phrases related to the Settlement and the Settlement Class, a sponsored link appeared providing brief information about the Settlement and Settlement Class and directed the user to the Settlement Website for more information.

PRESS RELEASE IN THE UNITED STATES AND U.S. TERRITORIES

19. On January 12, 2024, a press release was issued over PR Newswire's US1 Newlines. PR Newswire distributes to thousands of print and broadcast newsrooms nationwide, as well as websites, databases and online services. Kroll Media monitored

media outlets for mentions of the release in the news. Over 270 news mentions of the Settlement resulted from the press release.

20. Attached as **Exhibit F** is a copy of the press release and pick-up report.

CLAIM ACTIVITY

21. The Claims Deadline is April 15, 2024.

22. As of February 13, 2024, Kroll has received 258 Claim Forms through mail and 16,079 Claim Forms filed electronically through the Settlement Website. Kroll is still in the process of reviewing and validating Claim Forms.

OPT-OUTS, EXCLUSIONS AND OBJECTIONS

23. The Opt-Out and Objection Deadlines is March 14, 2024.

24. As of February 13, 2024, Kroll has received fifty-three (53) opt out requests and no objections to the Settlement. A list of the opt outs received is attached hereto as **Exhibit G**.

CONCLUSION

25. In my opinion, the Notice Program reflects a particularly appropriate, highly targeted, and contemporary way to provided notice to Settlement Class Members. Further, in my opinion, the efforts undertaken in this Notice Program are of the highest modern communication standards, are reasonably calculated to provide notice, and are consistent with best-practicable, Court-approved notice programs in similar matters and the Federal Judicial Center's guidelines concerning appropriate reach.

I declare under penalty of perjury, under the laws of the United States of America, that the foregoing is true and correct.

Pursuant to Section 3 of the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005 (“CAFA”), 28 U.S.C. § 1715, Defendant Lincare Holdings, Inc. (“Defendant” or “Lincare”) hereby notifies you of the proposed settlement of the above-captioned action (the “Action”), currently pending in the United States District Court, Middle District of Florida, Tampa Division (the “Court”).

Eight items must be provided to you in connection with any proposed class action settlement pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b). Each of these items is addressed below, and all exhibits are available for download at www.CAFANotice.com under the folder entitled *Lincare Holdings Inc. Data Breach Litigation*:

1. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(1) – a copy of the complaint and any materials filed with the complaint and any amended complaints.

The Class Action Complaint and the Consolidated Class Action Complaint are available as **Exhibits A & A1**.

2. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(2) – notice of any scheduled judicial hearing in the class action.

On October 6, 2023, Plaintiff filed a motion for preliminary approval of the class action settlement and the date of the preliminary approval hearing has not yet been set. The Court has not yet scheduled the Final Approval Hearing for this matter. The Motion for Preliminary Approval and the proposed Preliminary Approval Order are available as **Exhibits B and B1**.

3. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(3) – any proposed or final notification to class members.

Copies of the proposed Long Form Notice, Postcard Notice, Media Notice and Claim Form will be provided to Settlement Class Members and will be available on the Settlement Website created for the administration of this matter. These are available as **Exhibits C, D, E, and F** respectively. The Notices describe, among

other things, the Claim Form submission process, and the Settlement Class Members' rights to object or exclude themselves from the Class.

4. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(4) – any proposed or final class action settlement.

The Settlement Agreement is available as **Exhibit G**.

5. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(5) – any settlement or other agreement contemporaneously made between class counsel and counsel for defendants.

There are no other settlements or other agreements between Class Counsel and counsel for Defendant beyond what is set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

6. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(6) – any final judgment or notice of dismissal.

The Court has not yet entered a final judgment or notice of dismissal.

7. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(7) – (A) If feasible, the names of class members who reside in each State and the estimated proportionate share of the claims of such members to the entire settlement to that State's appropriate State official; or (B) if the provision of the information under subparagraph (A) is not feasible, a reasonable estimate of the number of class members residing in each State and the estimated proportionate share of the claims of such members to the entire settlement.

The definition of the Class in the proposed Settlement Agreement means:

All individuals in the United States whose PII was stored by Lincare Holdings Inc. and potentially disclosed, compromised, or accessed as a result of the cyber-breach or data incident experienced by Lincare Holdings Inc. in September 2021.

An estimated breakdown by state for known potential Settlement Class Members, and the estimated proportionate share of the claims of such members to the entire settlement is available as **Exhibit H**.

8. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(8) – any written judicial opinion relating to the materials described in 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b) subparagraphs (3) through (6).

There has been no written judicial opinion. Accordingly, no such document is presently available.

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You have been identified as a potential Settlement Class Member in a class action settlement. The Settlement has been filed in a class action lawsuit (the "Lawsuit") alleging unauthorized disclosure of personally identifiable information and protected health information (together "PII") that occurred on or about September 2021, when Lincare Holdings Inc. ("Defendant") experienced an intrusion into its system by an external individual (the "Incident"). The information that may have been disclosed in the Incident possibly included, first and last names, addresses, Lincare account numbers, date of birth, medical information, which may include information concerning medical treatments individuals received such as provider name, dates of service, diagnosis/procedure, and/or account or record numbers, health insurance information, and/or prescription information. In very limited circumstances, Social Security numbers may have been impacted in the Incident. **Defendant's records show that you may have been affected by the Incident, and thus you may be entitled to recover under the Settlement reached in the case.**

Your legal rights are affected whether you act or don't act, so read this Notice carefully.

In the Litigation, the Plaintiffs allege that Defendant violated certain duties with respect to the personal data of patients when patients' PII may have been compromised as a result of the Incident. Defendant denies any wrongdoing and denies all claims asserted against it in the Lawsuit. Both sides have agreed to settle the Lawsuit solely to avoid the cost, delay, and uncertainty of litigation.

The Settlement Class consists of all individuals in the United States whose PII was stored by Lincare Holdings Inc. and potentially disclosed, compromised, or accessed as a result of the cyber-breach or data incident experienced by Lincare Holdings Inc. in September 2021.

Contingent upon the Court's approval of the Settlement, Settlement Class Members who submit a valid and timely Claim may be entitled to: (a) reimbursement of certain Out-of-Pocket Losses resulting from the Incident; (b) reimbursement for Lost Time spent dealing with the effects or perceived effects of the Incident; and (c) monetary relief for Settlement Class Members who were residents of California during the time of the Incident (i.e., September 2021). Settlement Class Members may also enroll in 12 months of free identity theft protection and medical information monitoring through Medical Shield. The total amount of your Settlement Claim depends upon the type of losses you have experienced and the documentation you have for your Claim, as well as the total number of valid and timely Claims filed by all Settlement Class Members.

To make a Claim and qualify for payment or to request enrollment instructions for Medical Shield, you must submit a valid Claim Form by mail to Lincare Holdings Inc. Class Action, c/o Kroll Settlement Administration LLC, PO Box 225391, New York, NY 10150-5391 or online at www.LincareSettlement.com by **April 15, 2024**. A Claim Form is available at www.LincareSettlement.com or by calling (833) 383-4044. If you remain in the Settlement Class, you give up the right to sue Defendant and its related entities for any claim related to the Incident, **whether or not you submit a Claim.**

You can exclude yourself from the Settlement or you can object to the Settlement. If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself by March 14, 2024, or you will not be able to sue Defendant or its related entities for any claims relating to the Incident. If you exclude yourself, you cannot submit a Settlement Claim, get money from this Settlement, or enroll for coverage under Medical Shield. If you stay in the Settlement Class, you may object to the Settlement by March 14, 2024. To exclude yourself from or object to the Settlement, you must follow the instructions in the Full Notice, available at www.LincareSettlement.com.

To represent the Settlement Class, the Court has appointed John A. Yanchunis of Morgan & Morgan Complex Litigation Group and other counsel as "Class Counsel". For litigating the case and negotiating the Settlement, Class Counsel will file a motion seeking Court approval for the payment of their attorneys' fees and costs in an amount no greater than one third (33.3%, or \$2,416,666.67) of the Settlement Fund for attorneys' fees and no greater than Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$50,000.00) for reimbursement of litigation costs and expenses. You can hire your own separate lawyer, but you'll need to pay your own legal fees.

The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing on **June 12, 2024**, at the Sam Gibbons United States Federal Courthouse, 801 N. Florida Avenue, Courtroom 14A, Tampa, Florida 33602, to consider whether to approve the Settlement. The Court will hear any objections, determine if the Settlement is fair, and consider Class Counsel's request for fees and expenses. You may attend the Final Approval Hearing and ask to be heard by the Court, but you do not have to.

The information that may have been disclosed in the Incident possibly included, first and last names, addresses, Lincare account numbers, date of birth, medical information, which may include information concerning medical treatments individuals received such as provider name, dates of service, diagnosis/procedure, and/or account or record numbers, health insurance information, and/or prescription information. In very limited circumstances, Social Security numbers may have been impacted in the Incident.

As part of this Settlement, Defendant has agreed to pay eligible Settlement Class Members for certain types of Claims, extend or provide identity theft protection and medical information monitoring services, and undertake certain preventative security measures. You must submit a Settlement Claim using a Claim Form in order to receive any recovery under the Settlement.

1. What is this Lawsuit about?

In the Lawsuit, Plaintiffs bring claims against Defendant for negligence; negligence per se; breach of fiduciary duty; breach of implied contract; unjust enrichment; violation of the North Carolina Unfair and Deceptive Trade Practices Act (N.C. Gen. Stat. § 75-1.1, *et seq.*); violation of the California Confidentiality of Medical Information Act (Cal. Civ. Code § 56, *et seq.*); violation of the California Consumer Records Act (Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.82, *et seq.*); violation of the California Unfair Competition Law (Cal. Bus. & Prof. Code, § 17200, *et seq.*); violation of the Missouri Merchandising Practices Act (Mo. Ann. Stat. § 407.010, *et seq.*); and violation of New York General Business Law § 349, all related to the Incident.

Defendant denies any wrongdoing and denies all claims asserted against it in the Lawsuit. Both sides have agreed to settle the Lawsuit to avoid the cost, delay, and uncertainty of litigation.

2. What is a class action?

In a class action, a Settlement Class Representative (in this case, Plaintiffs Martha Chang, “B.B.”, Ronald Fudge, Victor Juarez, Cherry Merrell, George Miller, and Lisa Torres), sue on behalf of a group (or a “Class”) of people. Here, the Settlement Class Representative sued on behalf of people whose Personally Identifiable Information (“PII”) was stored by Defendant and potentially disclosed, compromised, or accessed as a result of the cyber-breach or data Incident experienced by Defendant in September 2021.

3. Why is there a Settlement?

To avoid the cost, risk, and delay of litigation, the Parties reached a Settlement as to the claims of Plaintiffs and the Settlement Class.

4. How do I know if I am a part of the Settlement?

For Settlement purposes, the Court has certified a Settlement Class consisting of all people who meet the following definition:

All individuals in the United States whose PII was stored by Lincare Holdings Inc. and potentially disclosed, compromised, or accessed as a result of the cyber-breach or data Incident experienced by Lincare Holdings Inc. in September 2021.

5. What relief is available to Settlement Class Members and how do I receive benefits?

To obtain a recovery, you must submit a Claim Form along with Reasonable Documentation and/or a proper attestation. This is the only way to get a payment or receive the identity theft protection and medical information monitoring services being offered by Defendant. Settlement Class Members who submit a valid and timely Claim Form, accompanied by proper documentation, may be entitled to the following forms of relief:

Category A Any Settlement Class Member can enroll for one year of Medical Shield monitoring services, commencing within thirty (30) days of the Effective Date of the Settlement. Medical Shield coverage (or its equivalent) will include, among other things, (i) healthcare insurance plan ID monitoring; (ii) medical record number monitoring; (iii) national provider identifier monitoring; (iv) Medicare Beneficiary Identifier monitoring; (v) International Classification of Diseases monitoring; (vi) Health Savings Account monitoring; (vii) Dark Web monitoring; (viii) \$1,000,000 Identity Theft Insurance; (ix) real-time authentication alerts; (x) high-risk transaction monitoring; (xi) security freeze assist; and (xii) immediate remediation assistance if

identity theft is suspected. Settlement Class Members seeking Medical Shield monitoring services must return the Claim Form and provide a valid email address or physical address. From there, after the Effective Date as defined in the Settlement Agreement, the Settlement Administrator will send enrollment instructions to all Settlement Class Members who submitted a Claim Form requesting enrollment instructions and providing a valid email address or physical address.

Category B Settlement Class Members who claim they suffered reasonable Out-of-Pocket Losses as a result of the Incident (“Out-of-Pocket Loss Claimants”) shall be entitled to reimbursement in an amount not to exceed a single payment of \$5,000 for Out-of-Pocket Losses fairly traceable to the Incident, which have not been reimbursed, and were incurred between September 10, 2021, and the date Settlement Class Members receive Notice of the Settlement.

To be eligible to receive up to, but not exceeding, \$5,000, a Settlement Class Member must submit a valid and timely Claim Form and Reasonable Documentation supporting the claim for Out-of-Pocket Losses, as specified in the Settlement Agreement, on or before the Claims Deadline, and such Claim Form must be approved by the Settlement Administrator.

Category C Settlement Class Members who claim they suffered Lost Time as a result of the Incident can submit a self-verifying statement under penalty of perjury for Lost Time and be reimbursed for up to four (4) hours at Twenty Dollars per hour (\$20/hour), in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Settlement Agreement (“Lost Time Claimant”). Lost-Time Claimants seeking Lost Time can submit a self-verifying statement for time spent dealing with the effects of the Incident, which must include a detailed explanation of the activities related to the Incident for which the time was spent.

Out-of-Pocket Loss Claimants whose claims meet or exceed the \$5,000.00 cap for Out-of-Pocket Losses are ineligible to seek relief for Lost Time. Moreover, a Settlement Class Member cannot recover an aggregate amount of more than \$5,000.00 for their combined Out-of-Pocket Loss Claim and Lost Time Claim.

Category D California Settlement Class Members can submit a Claim Form for an additional benefit of \$90.00 as recognition for their statutory claim(s) under California law (“California Claims”). To be eligible to receive compensation for California Claims, Settlement Class Members must submit a self-verifying statement under penalty of perjury that they were residents of California at the time of the Incident. This additional amount can be combined with either or both Out-of-Pocket-Expense Claims or Lost-Time Claims.

To the extent the total amount of all Valid Claims for Settlement Class Members (including for Out-of-Pocket Losses, Lost Time, and California Claims) at the end of the Claims Period were to exceed the amount in the Settlement Fund after payment of other expenses from the fund (including payments for all costs of administration of the Settlement and the Notice Program; the costs for Identity Theft Protection (Medical Shield monitoring); and any Fee and Expense Award approved by the Court for or awarded to Class Counsel), the cash benefits to each eligible Settlement Class Member with a Valid Claim would be decreased on a *pro rata* basis. To the extent the total amount of all Valid Claims for Settlement Class Members (including for Out-of-Pocket Losses, Lost Time, and California Claims) at the end of the Claims Period were to be less than the amount in the Settlement

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Fund after payment of other expenses from the fund (including payments for all costs of administration of the Settlement and the Notice Program; the costs for Identity Theft Protection (Medical Shield monitoring); and any Fee and Expense Award approved by the Court for or awarded to Class Counsel), the cash benefits to each eligible Settlement Class Member with a Valid Claim would be increased on a *pro rata* basis, subject to a maximum of One Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000.00) for each California Claims payment.

All Claim Forms must be mailed no later than the Claims Deadline of April 15, 2024.

In addition to the monetary benefits described above, Defendant further has implemented, and/or have agreed to implement, and agrees to maintain, security measures to protect the PII of its patients for a period of no less than one (1) year after the Effective Date (“Enhanced Data Security Measures”). Any costs associated with the Enhanced Data Security Measures will be borne by Defendant and not paid from the Settlement Fund. The Enhanced Data Security Measures include the following:

- i. Defendant engages, and will continue to engage, third-party security service providers and internal personnel to run automated security monitoring;
- ii. Defendant audits, tests, and trains, and will continue to audit, test, and train, its security personnel regarding any new or modified procedures;
- iii. Defendant segments, and will continue to segment, data by, among other things, creating firewalls and access controls;
- iv. Defendant conducts, and will continue to conduct, regular computer system scanning and security checks;
- v. Defendant routinely conducts, and will continue to conduct, internal training and education to inform employees about the best practices to implement to recognize and avoid electronic threats and internal security personnel about how to identify and contain a breach when it occurs and what to do in response to a breach;
- vi. Defendant retains, and will continue to retain, a Head of Information Security and Architecture who will ensure that all security/technical personnel are qualified to fulfill the roles to which they are assigned; and
- vii. Defendant maintains, and will continue to maintain, a lifecycle management plan to keep updated as needed.

6. What am I giving up to receive these benefits?

By staying in the Settlement Class, all of the Court’s orders will apply to you, and you will give Defendant a “release.” A release means you cannot sue or be part of any other lawsuit against Defendant concerning the claims or issues in this Lawsuit (relating to the Incident), and you will be bound by the Settlement. The specific claims you are giving up against Defendant, its affiliates, and related persons or entities are called “Released Claims.” The Released Claims are described in Section XI of the Settlement Agreement, which is available at www.LincareSettlement.com. The Settlement Agreement describes the Released Claims with specific and accurate legal descriptions, so read it carefully.

7. Do I have a lawyer in this case?

To represent the Settlement Class, the Court has appointed John A. Yanchunis (Morgan & Morgan), Stephen R. Basser (Barrack, Rodos & Bacine), Raina Borrelli (Turke & Strauss LLP), Alexandra M. Honeycutt (Milberg, Coleman, Bryson, Phillips, Grossman PLLC), and Carl V. Malmstrom (Wolf Haldenstein Adler Freeman & Herz LLC) as “Class Counsel.” You can contact Class Counsel at:

For litigating the case and negotiating the Settlement, Class Counsel will request from the Court an award of attorneys' fees not to exceed one-third (33.3%, or \$2,416,666.67) of the Settlement Fund and reimbursement of litigation costs and expenses not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$50,000.00) (collectively, the "Fee and Expense Award"). Any Fee and Expense Award is subject to Court approval. You may hire your own separate attorney, but only at your own expense.

8. I don't want to be part of this case. How do I ask to be excluded?

If you don't want a payment or the identity theft protection service offered by this Settlement and you want to keep the right to sue Defendant about issues relating to the Incident, then you must take steps to get out of the Settlement. This is called "excluding" yourself or "opting out" of the Settlement Class.

To exclude yourself, you must send a letter by mail that (i) states your full name, address and telephone number, (ii) contains your signature or the signature of the person authorized by law to sign on behalf of you, and (iii) states unequivocally that you intend to be excluded from the Settlement Class and from the Settlement. You must mail your exclusion request, postmarked no later than the Opt-Out Deadline of **March 14, 2024**, to: Lincare Holdings Inc. 9. How do I object to the Settlement?

Your objection must include (i) the name of the Litigation; (ii) your full name, address, email address, and telephone number; (iii) an explanation of the basis upon which you claim to be a Settlement Class Member; (iv) all grounds for the objection, accompanied by any legal support for the objection; (v) the identity of all counsel who represent you, including any former or current counsel who previously represented you and may be entitled to compensation for any reason related to the objection to the Settlement, the fee application, or the application for Service Award; (vi) the identity of all counsel representing you who will appear at the Final Approval Hearing; (vii) the number of times in which you have objected to a class action Settlement within the five (5) years preceding the date on which you file the objection, and the caption of each case in which you have made such objections; (viii) the number of times in which your counsel and/or counsel's law firm have objected to a class action Settlement within the five (5) years preceding the date that you file the objection for the ten (10) most recent objections, and the caption of each case in which the counsel or the firm has made such objections; (ix) a list of any persons who will be called to testify at the Final Approval Hearing in support of the objection; (x) a statement confirming whether you intend to personally appear and/or testify at the Final Approval Hearing.

If you wish to object to the proposed Settlement, you must mail or hand-deliver written objections to the Settlement ("Objections") to the Settlement Administrator or Court. Alternatively, you or your counsel may file Objections with the Court through the Court's electronic case filing ("ECF") system, with service on Class Counsel and Defendant's Counsel made through the ECF system.

Objections also must be postmarked or electronically filed with the Settlement Administrator or Court on or
